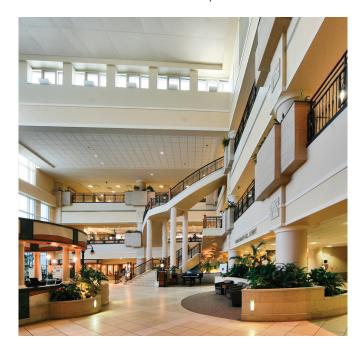
- Broward Health Coral Springs in 2014 became the first hospital in Florida to be Joint Commission certified for its minimally invasive colorectal surgery program.
