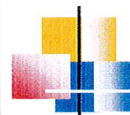

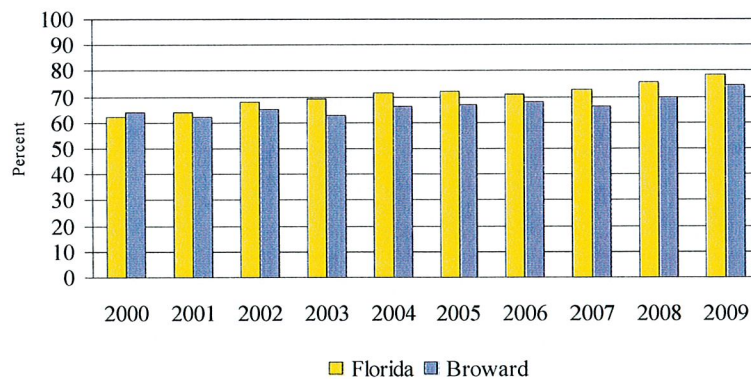

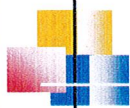
Broward Graduation Rates

Comparison of District to State



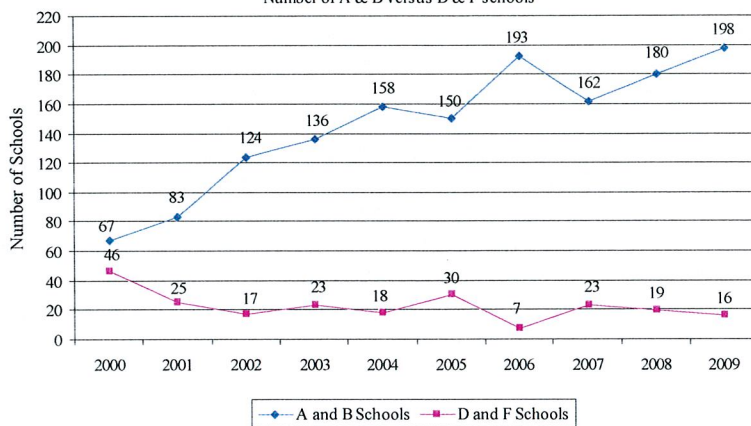
Reflects FDOE cohort graduation rate. Increased by more than 10% from 2000 to 2009

School Grades in Broward 2000-2009

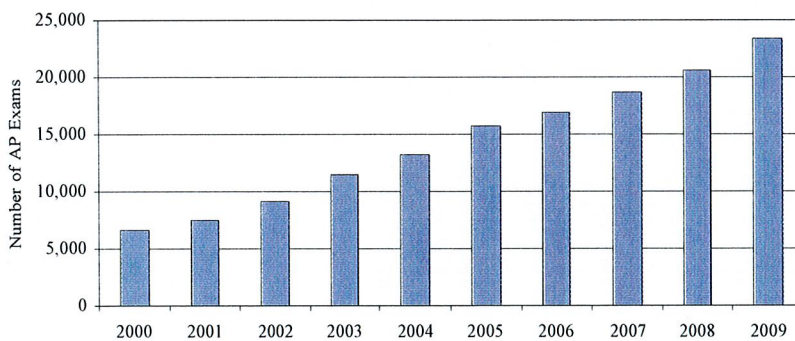
Number of A & B versus D & F schools

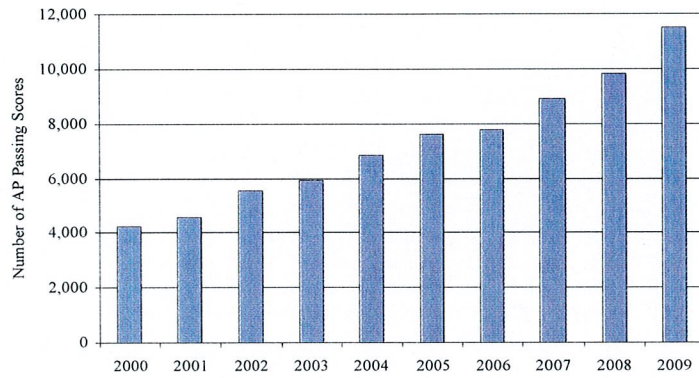

by All Broward Students



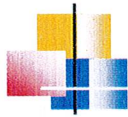

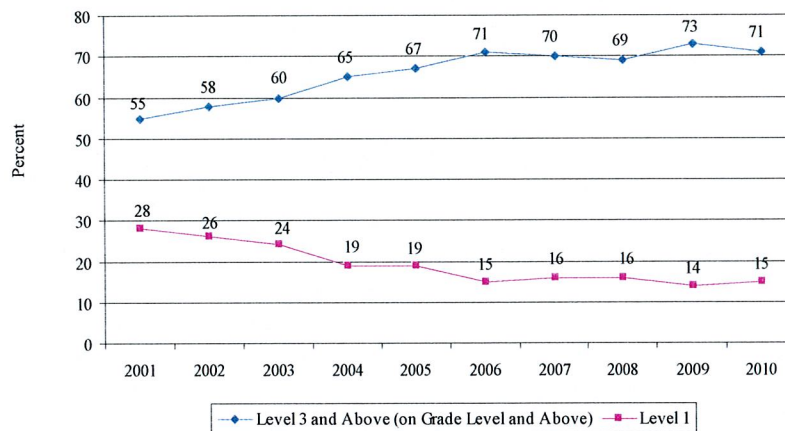

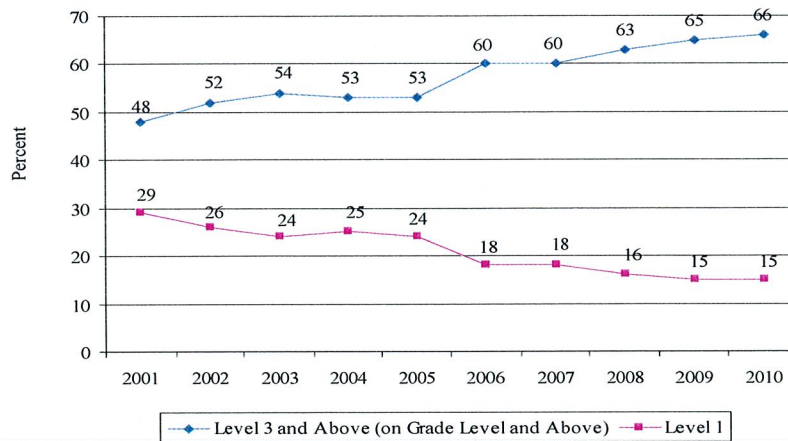

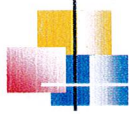
Grades 3, 4, and 5



Broward Middle School Students FCAT Reading

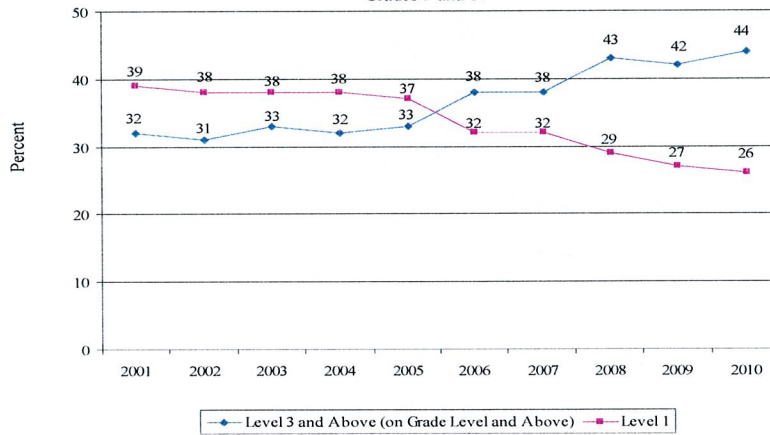

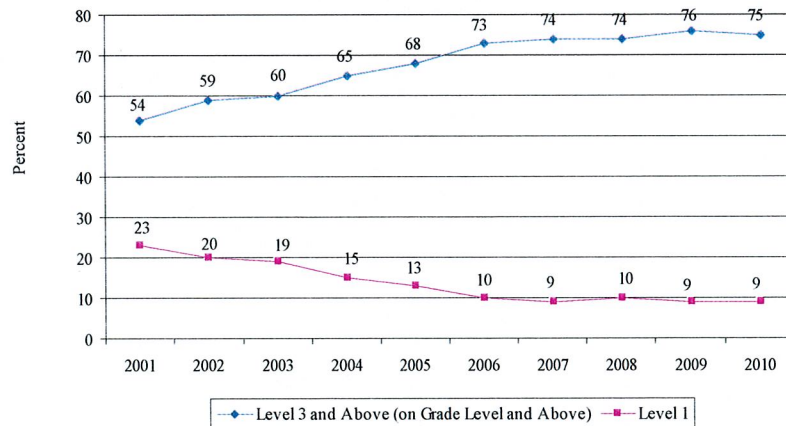
Broward High School Students FCAT Reading

Broward Elementary School Students FCAT Mathematics

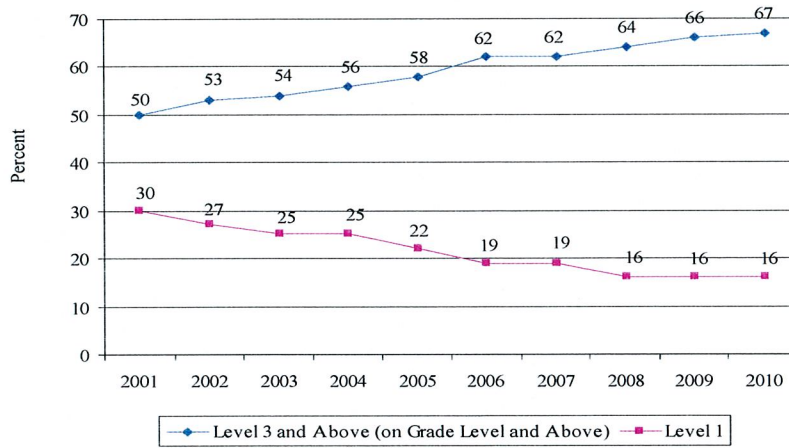

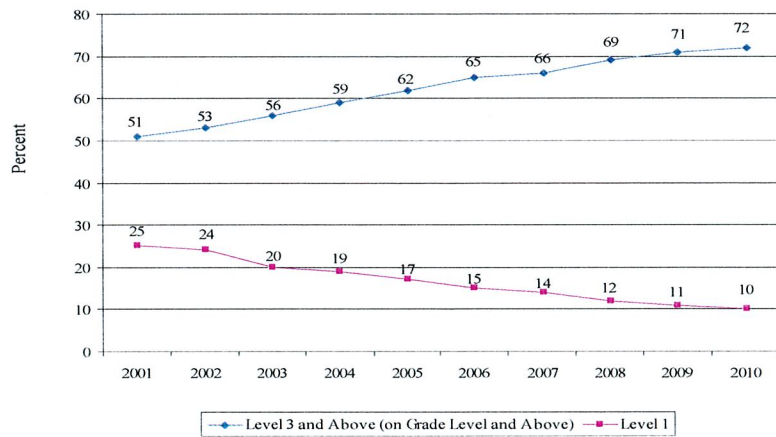
Broward Middle School Students FCAT Mathematics

BROWARD COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS POINTS OF PRIDE

For two consecutive years, BCPS was a finalist for the Broad Prize presented by the California-based Broad Foundation. The Broad Prize is considered to be the "Pulitzer Prize" in the field of education.

Five Broward high schools have been ranked among the Best High Schools in the nation for 2010 by U.S. News & World Report. All five high schools (out of 21,786 nationwide) received silver medals representing the top 3% of high schools in the country.

For nine consecutive years, BCPS has been recognized by CGCS for meeting or exceeding State averages for 8th grade reading & 4th and 8th grade mathematics.

BCPS continues to lead the nation, for the fifth consecutive year, in the number of National Board Certified Teachers. The District has a total of 1,726 board certified teachers.

In what is likely a first for any collegiate high school in the nation, 100% of the 2010 graduates of the College Academy at Broward College earned an AA degree along with their high school diploma.

Broward Virtual School has been recognized as the top performing Florida Virtual School franchise in the state for 2008/09 and 2009/10; over 300 students enrolled from KG through Grade 12.
